<p>The most highly visible activity of the CIT 2002 conference.</p> <p>Vendors interested in presenting at the conference:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are asked to include or collaborate with an institute of higher learning on the presentation • Present for a 30 minute duration • Must submit an abstract of their presentation of 400 words or less, using the electronic submission form on the CIT 2002 web site (http://www.cit.suny.edu). • Submissions are accepted through January 25th 2002 • Accepted presenters will be notified on February 8th 2002 • Wear a name badge identifying wearer as a PRESENTOR • Receive a complete list of CIT 2002 attendees 	

Level II: Exhibitor Booth & “Breakfast with the Vendors”	Fee: \$300.00
<p>This year’s conference has scheduled two exhibitor sessions: Session 1 – Technology Showcase is set for Tuesday, May 28th from 7:00pm to 9:30pm Session 2 – Technology Showcase is set for Wednesday, May 29th from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm</p> <p>A large exhibit space has been set aside, and shall serve as the focal point of the conference. Exhibitors will have an opportunity to meet faculty and professional support staff face-to-face and can display their latest products to a select audience. In addition, exhibitors can get promotional materials with their company name into the hands of potential customers.</p> <p>All Exhibitors may attend “Breakfast with the Vendors” on Wednesday, May 29th from 6:30-8:00 am, where vendors will be able to meet faculty and support professionals in a casual, conversational arena.</p> <p>As an exhibitor, you will receive the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A 10 foot display area, one (1) draped 6 foot table and 2 chairs in the exhibit area • A name badge identifying you as an EXHIBITOR / EDUCATIONAL PARTNER
